

Passover 2010

It's hard to believe, but Passover is just around the corner. Below is the information about Hillel's Passover meal options.

Please note that Hillel must order its Passover food in advance and therefore meals can only be guaranteed to those who make advance reservations and payment. Please return the order form and payment to the Hillel office by Friday, March 19.

SEDER: Hillel will host a seder on the first night of Passover, Monday, March 29 at 6:30 p.m. Hillel will not hold a Seder on the second night of Passover, however, we will make arrangements for students to host their own seders or to be hosted in local homes. If you are a student or community member who would like to host students at your home for the second night Seder or if you are a student and would like home hospitality, please fill out the 2nd Seder Information Sheet.

LUNCHESES: Lunch will be available on weekdays from 11-2. An assortment of salads, spreads, fruit, yogurt, soup and of course, matzah and matzah pizza will be available for students to create their own lunches. Pre-ordered box lunches will be available on the weekend. Arrangements for box lunch pick-up must be made in advance with Hillel staff.

DINNERS: Meat dinners with vegetarian options will be available **by reservation only** as follows:

COST: Please see the order form for complete charges for students and non-students. In addition to the charges noted, students on the URI Dining plan will have \$3 deducted from their plan for each meal reserved and/or eaten at Hillel.

Please consider making a donation to Hillel above the price charged for the meals or even if you are not ordering meals. These donations make it possible for Hillel to provide URI's only kosher-for-Passover meals. For each donation of \$36 you may dedicate a copy of the "On Wings of Freedom" haggadah we use for the seder.

EXTRA: The Hillel staff is available to provide resources to students who would like to host their own seders and guidance to those who wish to eat selectively in the dining halls.
